GENETICALLY MODIFIED ORGANISMS (GMOs) POLICY

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Charoen Pokphand Foods Public Company Limited and its subsidiaries give importance on safety and quality of products to address the needs and health of our consumers. Thus, the Company and its subsidiaries have been investing in research and development to enhance nutrition and health of consumers of all ages. We source raw materials from responsible sources, control quality by using internationally-accepted standards throughout the value chain from raw materials to end process, and consider using raw materials that are the products of biotechnology as the alternative. These are, however, based on rigorous scientific research and within the assessment on consumer safety by related government agencies. The Company and its subsidiaries recognize that biotechnology plays a vital role in agricultural sector nowadays as it helps enhance food security by increasing yield, resisting pests and diseases, and enduring the changing climate. Nevertheless, the Company and its subsidiaries also take into consideration public concerns regarding impacts that may occur on consumers' health and the environment, particularly on biodiversity, from the use of raw materials for our products and reduce global self-reliance in food. The Company and its subsidiaries, therefore, determine the Policy by adhering and giving priority on consumers' benefits.

In order to deliver customers and consumers high quality, nutritious, safe and tasty products at a reasonable price, the Company determines the following practices for products produced from genetically modified raw materials:

1. Raw Material Sourcing

All raw materials including GM raw materials shall be sourced in rigorous compliance with the Sustainable Sourcing Policy and Supplier Guiding Principle. Any potential health and environment risks, including potential risks related to GMOs, shall be reported and evaluated and GMO traceability process shall be in place.

2. Processing

The Company shall place high importance on production process in line with international standards. The storage facilities for genetically modified raw materials shall be strictly controlled.

### 3. Product Information and Communication

The Company shall respect and strictly comply with the laws and regulations on GMO labelling of any country in which it operates or invests in. The Company also takes into account customer's requirements on GMO labelling that are more stringent and even where not required by law, where appropriate. Furthermore, the Company shall provide channels for consumers and interested parties to address their concerns.
